## Yarmouth Grayhound Homefinders Policy Statement

Using photographs on the Yarmouth Greyhound Homefinder's website, in the Newsletter or on Social Media by members of staff or registered volunteers.

This policy has been approved by the Trustees of Yarmouth Greyhound Homefinders (YGH) to ensure as far as is possible that the data protection rights of those in any photograph/video that is used on the YGH website, in the Newsletter or on Social Media are not infringed.

## Photographs containing images of recognisable adults (18 years of age or over).

Where a such a person is recognisable in the photograph/video it is always best practice wherever practicable to ask for permission (preferably written) to use the photograph on YGH website, in the Newsletter or on Social Media

Sometimes it may not be practicable to seek permission from all the people in a photograph/video. For example photographs/videos of groups of people at one of our Open Days. But even in such cases consent should be sought as and when possible.

#### Photographs containing images of recognisable children.

But wherever a photograph contains the image of a person under the age of 18 years (a child in law) who can be recognised the photograph must not be used on YGH website, in the Newsletter or on Social Media unless the YGH consent form has been fully completed and signed.

The administrators will take very care to ensure that the above policy is adhered to when approving posts containing photographs/videos of recognisable people,particularly children under the age of 18 years. Anyone submitting a post on YGH Facebook page or any other YGH Social Media platform must comply with this policy. Any post etc that is submitted that does not comply with this policy will not be approved and/or will be taken down.

The webmaster will take very care to ensure that the above policy is adhered to when putting up photographs/videos of recognisable people.

Towards the end of his life he patiently allowed me to change dressings on his very painful leg two or three times a day. Never once did he complain and would just lie there and let me



change them. Finally he had a haemorrhage from the tumour and it was time to say goodbye. He passed away very peacefully at home.

He was friend to everyone and every dog. He was an expert at persuading folk to stroke him, especially when he was collecting at the Stadium. The children all loved him as he patiently stood there while they made a fuss of him. A true ambassador for the breed. Molly chose him for me very soon after losing my old boy, Marley, he never replaced him but became an equally good ambassador for greyhounds. Thank you Molly.
